



Students' Accommodation

Module 1 of the training is held in Sussex and consist of four very intensive in person training.

Unless the student is local to the training venue (East Sussex/Kent area), we recommend near-by accommodation.

Depending on the number of students requiring accommodation, the school can book a house to provide individual bedroom, kitchen etc. facilities.

Alternatively, local Airb&b can be booked directly by the student but taxying to and from the training venue is only possible if the accommodation is booked through the school.

Although the student is not obliged to join in the accommodation scheme, the recommended accommodation budget for module 1 for an individual bedroom is around £100 per night.

Module 2 and 3 of the training (clinical practice) are usually held in London and can also be organised in East Sussex if more convenient. The Clinic Centre in London is located at 113 Camden Mews, London, NW1 9AH.
